V. Brent has been nominated for the Board of Directors for the MTFCA. Ballots are in the latest issue of Vintage Magazine. Dave also said that Brent & Nancy are on a Board of the Museum trying to organize the inventory and space to get the Museum back on track. This is the guidance that the Museum needs to become a true asset to the history of T's.

VI. Dave N. brought up that he and Cheri had driven to the Hagerstown Tour at Hagerstown IN. It coincides with the Oshkosh Experimental Aircraft show. The local small airport is a hub for fliers going to the show and the area provides a great variety of activities plus an array of antique shops.

- VII. Doug D said that he and Karen had worked out a proposed tour in Urbana that would be a short, one day tour, starting at Gaslight Auto and loop up to the Castles in West Liberty and returning to Urbana. Lunch would be at the Grimes Field Air Port Cafe. We are hoping Bob and Ray from Gaslight will sponsor the tour next year.
- VIII. It was pointed out that last years Berlin Tour's usual date was in conflict with the Home Coming Show & Tell in Richmond and the mid June date was chosen because wedding dates tied up all but that date. This year the Home Coming is the first Saturday in June.
- IX. A possible tour in the Groveport area with a stop over at Pete Steeplton's place was discussed.
- X. We discussed that the place for the Christmas Party was going to be rather expensive and should we look elsewhere for a location. Doug suggested the Nutcracker in Pataskala as an alternative. They have a free room for up to 50, the complete meal is \$10. Enough said, Doug D was asked to book the Nutcracker if available. Dave and Cheri N said they would see if The Farmstead would be available for the January meeting. We are looking for suggested places around Columbus for meeting locations that give more members an easier venue to attend.
- XI. Tracy T notified Rick and Doug that she and Ted are incredibly busy and she asked that she and Ted not be nominated for an office this coming year. Nadine Whiteman volunteered to serve as Secretary *pro tem* for the remainder of this year.
